

# Bestem T-Box Mounting Kit Installation

Thank you for your purchase of Bestem T-Box Mounting Kit. Please take a moment going through this manual before starting the installation process.

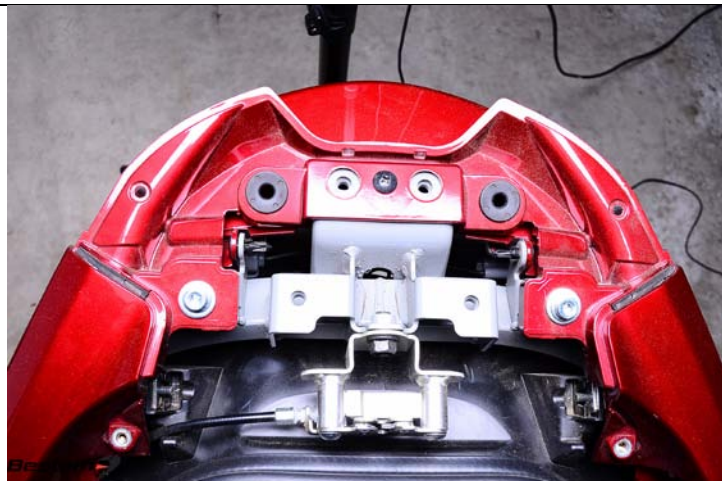

## Tools Required

Power drill, step drill bit (3/4"), and M8 Allen wrench.

The following installation was performed on a Burgman 400. For Burgman 650, the installation is very similar except for the number of holes have to be drilled on the tail cover.

Step 1. Remove the tail cover and you will see four threaded (three for the 650) holes underneath. The adaptor plate will be mounted onto these holes.



Step 2. Drill with the step-drill bit on the back of the tail cover where it has been pre-marked. Make sure the cover is well secured before drilling. The holes are drilled to  $\frac{3}{4}$ " in diameter and then slightly bored out to accommodate the spacers.

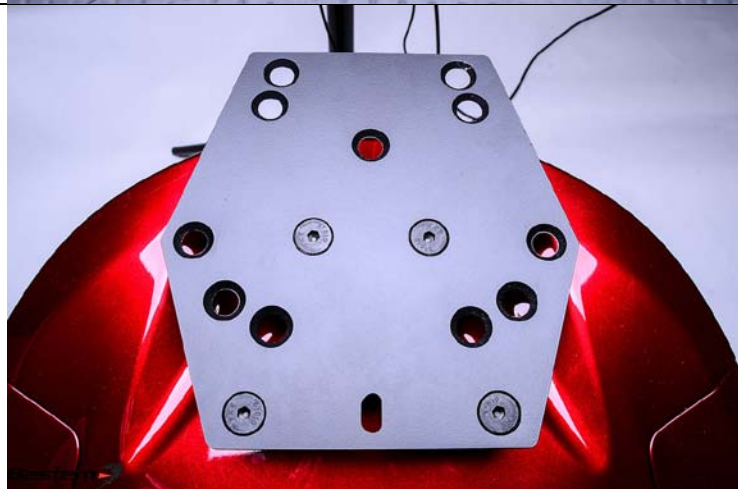


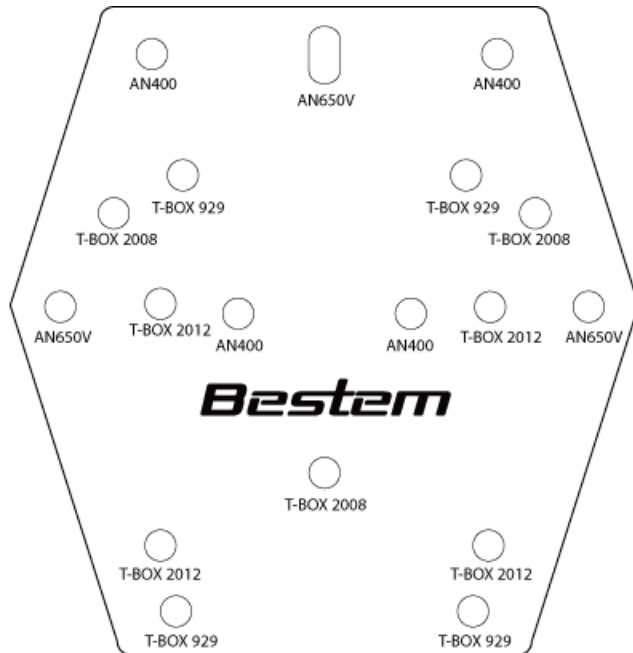
Step 3. Replace the tail cover, and insert the spacers. For 650 model, the longest spacer will be inserted at the hole that's the closest to the seat.



Step 4. Mount the adaptor plate onto the subframe using the screws provided. Please use the plate diagram on the following page as a reference. If you're installing a T-Box 2012 onto a Burgman 650, the T-Box mounting plate will share the same two holes with the adaptor plate (in the middle of the plate).

**Note: Do not exceed loading limit specified by your motorcycle's manufacture. Periodically check hardware security.**

1. AN400 - Mounting holes for Burgman 400
2. AN650 - Mounting holes for Burgman 650
3. Apply thread-loc on all screws.
